## Ring Size



Cut a slip of paper and wrap around your finger.
(Don't use string, it stretches)


Mark the point where the end of paper meets.


Use a ruler to measure the inside circumference. Refer to the table below

| US <br> Ring size | 4 | 5 | 6 | 7 | 8 | 9 | 10 | 11 | 12 | 13 |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Circumference <br> $(\mathrm{mm})$ | 46.5 | 49.0 | 51.5 | 54.0 | 56.5 | 59.1 | 61.6 | 64.1 | 66.6 | 69.1 |

Alternatively, simply take a ring that fits you perfectly and check the inner diameter of the piece, using a ruler. If your ring size falls between two of the sizes shown, choose the larger size.
